- Selecting and organization of high-quality workshops and presenters for state convention
- Supporting and coordinating Visual & Performing Arts with music needs for convention
- Planning the Friday Night Fun and Fellowship (Friday Night Fling) at the state convention
- Planning and assisting the First Vice President with the Celebration Luncheon at the state convention to honor Doctoral Degrees, members with 40 years or more of membership, and Birthday Chapters
- Supporting chapters with Program ideas and involvement with state projects and opportunities
- Planning and enacting the Purposeful Seminar in even-numbered years
- Supporting the Leadership Development in even-numbered years
- Supporting the planning and implementation of the Creative Arts Retreat in odd-numbered years
