REPORT OF THE PA STATE SCHOLARSHIP COMMITTEE

June 2023

I. ROLE Address Purpose 5

- A. Endow scholarships to qualified, outstanding members in their pursuit of graduate study or degree.
- B. Award enrichment grants to eligible members in their focus of the pursuit of personal and professional advancement and at least one other of the DKG Seven Purposes.

II. BIENNIAL GOALS

The Committee

- A. Annually reviews and selects eligible and active outstanding applicants to be awarded scholarships and enrichment grants.
- B. Reviews and updates the scholarship and enrichment grant application and guidelines to be posted on the website and in the Keystonian.
- C. Stresses the multiple ways members may use the enrichment grants for personal and professional advancement of their lives and the lives of others.
- D. Plans for the presentation of the awards at the annual state convention.
- E. Maintains and annually updates the archive Scholarship Book of the scholarship and enrichment grant recipients for the historical records.
- F. Highlights and publishes in the Keystonian the recipients' uses of their scholarships and grants.
- G. Emphasizes chapter presidents to encourage their members to apply for state and international scholarships.

III. ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- A. The Committee awarded four scholarships in 2022.
 - i.One, Marian Spitzer Robling, to a member in her first three years of membership in DKG and three to members who were pursuing graduate study for advanced certification or degrees.
 - ii. The nine recipients of the 2022 enrichment grants shared their experiences in articles submitted to the Keystonian.
- B. In 2023 the committee awarded four scholarships to individuals pursuing advanced degrees.
 - i. Additional awards to two of the recipients through memorial and honor gifts.
 - ii. Seven enrichment grants were awarded in 2023, and one additional grant was awarded through a grant in memory of Wanda Keller, our former treasurer.

IV. RECOMMENDATIONS 2023-2024

- A. The Committee will encourage and promote members to apply for international and state scholarships for advanced graduate study.
- B. The Committee will promote the applicant submissions for scholarship and grant submissions through the Keystonian and the State President's communications with chapter presidents.
- C. Chapter Presidents will be requested to use the Chapter President Guidelines in preparing applicant recommendations.
