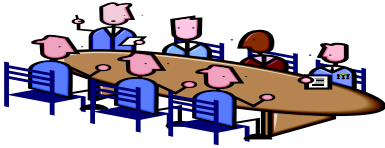




# Delta Kappa Gamma Beta Gamma Chapter 2017 Summer Newsletter from your Presidents
