# LeOra Held Recruitment Grant Awarded

Honor Student and All Mid-Penn First Team soccer star Sharon Juarez captured the LeOra Held Scholarship from Omega Chapter, Delta Kappa Gamma, at the Greencastle-Antrim High School Awards Assembly last week. In addition to the DKG award, given annually to a deserving student who plans to pursue a career in education, Sharon captured a \$5,000 G-A Education Foundation Ambassador Award, the \$5,000 Shippensburg University Board of Governors' Scholarship; the Sociedad Honoraria Hispanica Award, an Exchange Club Scholarship, and two other \$2,000 local scholarships.

Presented by Shannon Harvey, active member of Delta Kappa Gamma, the women educators' society, and Harrisburg Area Community College Vice President and director of its Gettysburg Campus, the LeOra Held Recruitment Grant was established in 1951 by Omega Chapter of DKG to give future women educators a boost at the start of their education studies. It honors LeOra Held, an outstanding English teacher and Guidance Counselor while serving in leadership positions at the state and national levels of Delta Kappa Gamma.

In her award winning essay, Sharon predicted a bright future: "I visualize myself as a new Kindergarden teacher and the new Head Varsity Soccer Coach at a public high school ... not only changing the lives of the young students in my classroom, but also the lives of the girl soccer players I will coach ... My mother and father never had the chance to attend college and follow their dream ... however, my family background has given me the motivation to make sure I am successful in whatever I aspire."

In addition to playing soccer and remaining on the Distinguished Honor Roll for four years, Sharon was a member of both the National Honor Society and Spanish National Honor Society, fundraising coordinator for Feeding America, a teacher's aide for Child Fellowship Evangelism and a Peer Tutor.

In the fall, Sharon will attend Shippensburg University as a member of its Honors Program and play soccer for the Lady Raiders. She plans to double-major in Elementary Education and Spanish.
