

REPORT OF THE AD HOC COMMITTEE FOR STRATEGIC ACTION PLANNING

I. The role of the Alpha Alpha State Ad Hoc Committee for Strategic Action

Planning is to review the mission and vision statements and the seven Society purposes to determine the vision for our state organization and select areas on which to focus. Directed by the Administrative Board, the committee selected three areas of focus--Membership, Communication, Leadership--and developed objectives and activities to give the state a long term plan of action.

II. Biennial Goals

- A. To continue to work with the committees and individuals who are responsible for implementing the various objectives and activities of the Alpha Alpha State Strategic Action Plan
- B. To aid chapters in developing their own SAP, the Ad Hoc committee has posted the Alpha Alpha State SAP, "Successful Chapter Model," and "SAP...a Plan for Your Chapter's Future" on the state website to aid chapters in developing their own SAP
- C. Communicate with chapters who seek additional help

III. Accomplishments Related to Goals

After the plan was approved by the 2013 State Executive Board, the Ad Hoc Committee communicated with all responsible persons in February to check measurement of the activities of the state plan. The committee is providing help where needed. The committee is available to any chapter wishing to have more help in getting started with their own plan.

IV. Other Actions of the Committee

The committee is considering new areas of focus for the state plan and will continue to act as a resource for any committee or chapter seeking help.
