

STATE ACHIEVEMENT COMMITTEE

I. The Role of our committee is two-fold:

- (1) to receive and process nominations for the Rosebud Recognition in the first year of the state's biennium. A part of this process has been to create an application form and to promote the recognition through the state website, *The Keystoneian*, and any state conferences and events.
- (2) to receive and process nominations for the State Achievement Award in the second year of the state's biennium as well as to promote the achievement award through the state website, *The Keystoneian*, and any state conferences and events.

II. Biennial Goals

1. Inform the membership of Alpha Alpha State of the significance, criteria and availability of the Rosebud Recognition (RR) and the State Achievement Award (SAA).
2. Create a RR nomination form and update the RR guidelines.
3. Update the SAA nomination form and guidelines, including an update form for nominations previously received (but not awarded) and re-submitted for consideration.
4. Encourage chapter presidents to submit nominations of worthy members for the RR and SAA.
5. Receive nominations for the RR and SAA.
6. Choose a recipient for the RR and SAA.
7. Arrange for purchase of the presentation gifts for the RR and SAA.
8. Plan and give the presentation of the RR and SAA for the State Convention.
9. Document the name of the recipient each year in the final business session minutes .
10. Celebrate each recipient in an article about her in the Summer edition of *The Keystoneian* immediately following her recognition/award at convention.
11. Participate in convention workshops and presentations as requested by the state president.

III. Accomplishments Related to Goals

^Our committee has received and processed the Rosebud Recognition nominations and chosen a recipient to receive this recognition at the Alpha Alpha State Convention in 2014. A presentation and gift have been planned. Contact with her chapter president has been made.

^We have met as a committee at the February 28/March 1, 2014 Leadership Conference in State College as well as "meeting" numerous times via email. Plans for the Rosebud Recognition presentation at Convention 2014 were made and the convention workshop plans solidified.

IV. Other Actions of the Committee

We will meet on 13 June 2014 at the Alpha Alpha State Convention to check our plans for both the workshop and the presentation. At that meeting, we will discuss committee ideas/plans and take assignments of responsibilities for the 2014-15 State Achievement Award work.
